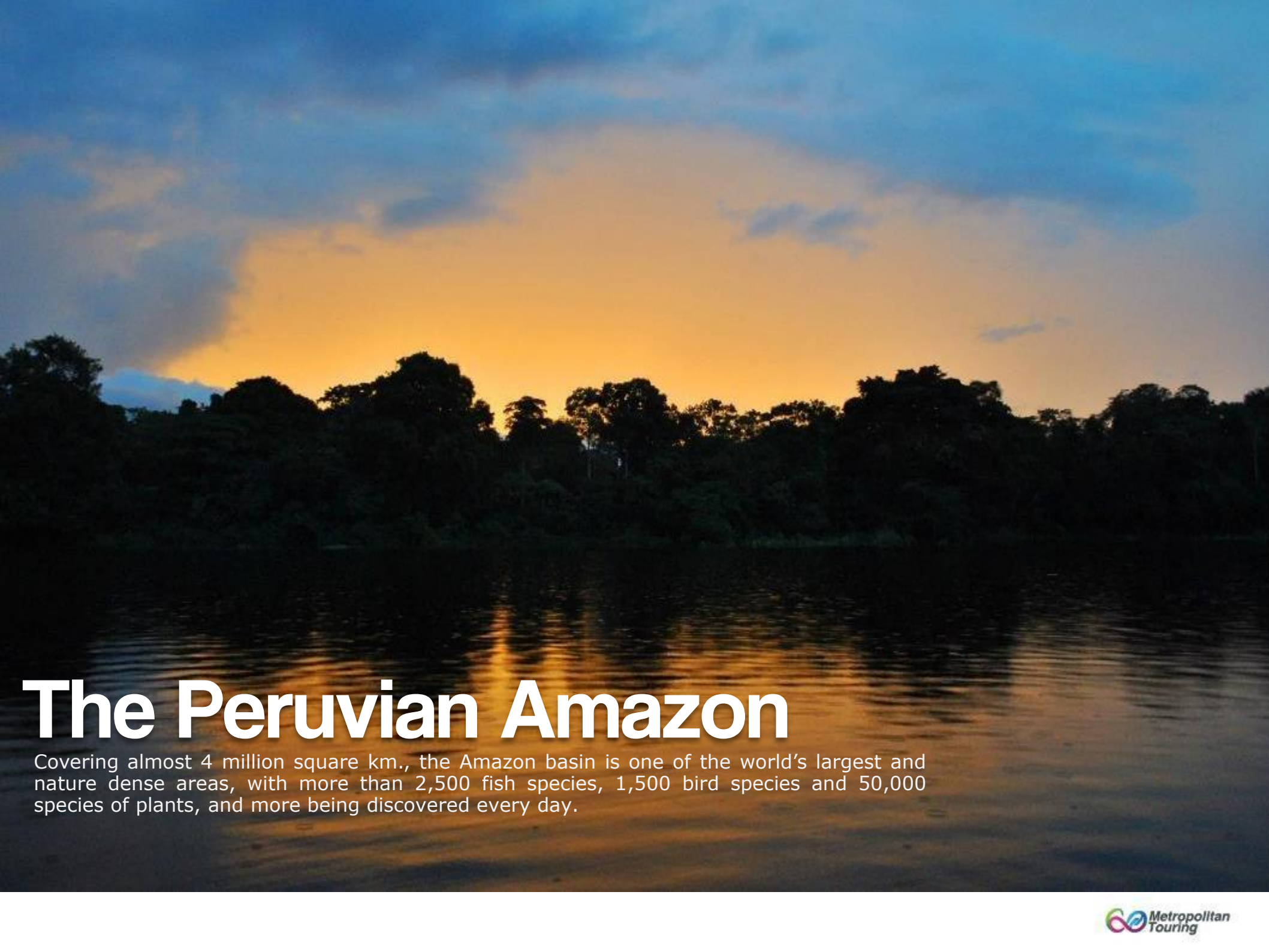

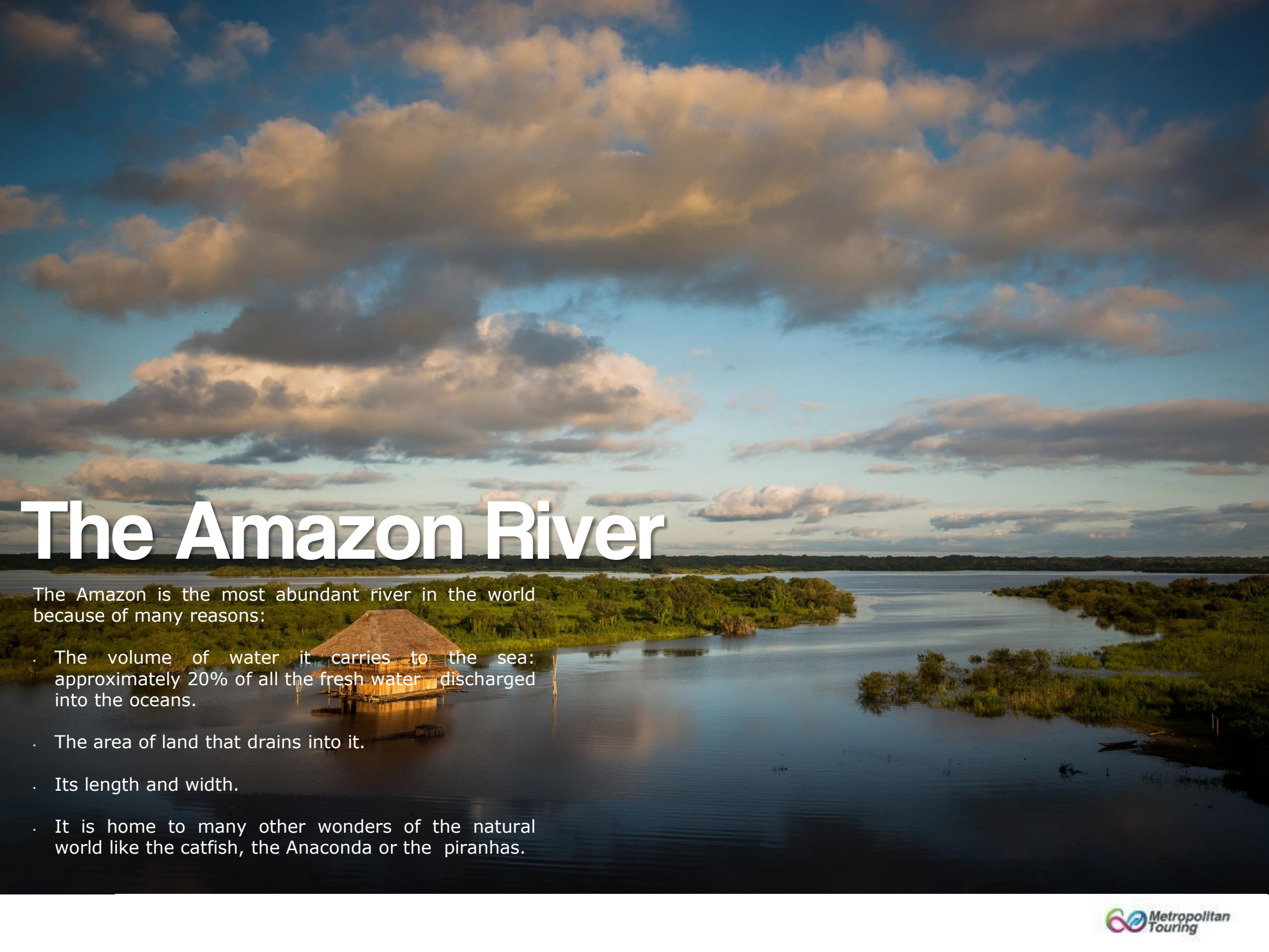


The Peruvian Amazon

- The volume of water it carries to the sea: approximately 20% of all the fresh water discharged into the oceans.
- The area of land that drains into it.
- Its length and width.
- It is home to many other wonders of the natural world like the catfish, the Anaconda or the piranhas.



Pacaya Samiria Reserve

The biggest of all Peru's many national reserves, the Pacaya Samiria covers 21,000 square kilometers / 8,100 square miles. Just over 40,000 people currently call the Pacaya Samiria their home. 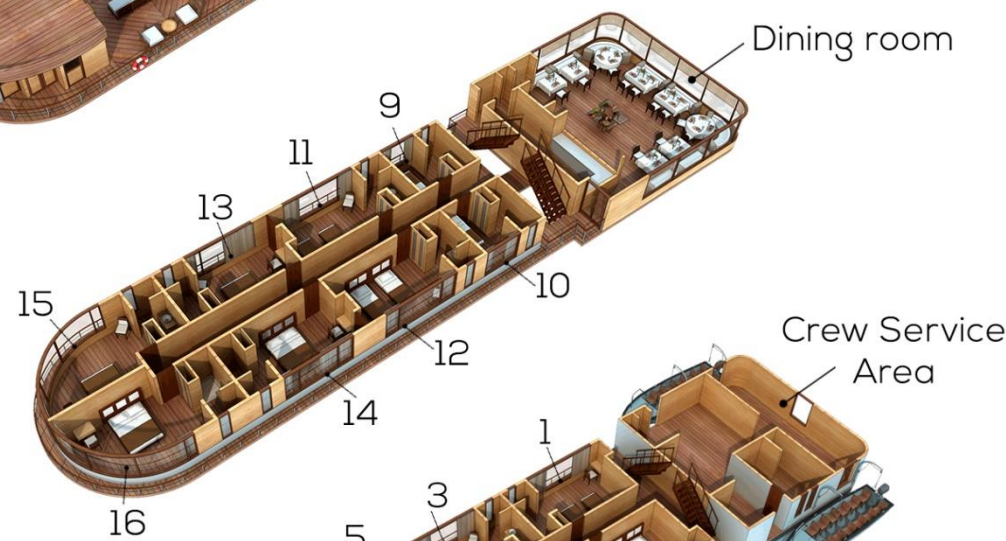
Delfin II - Deck Plan

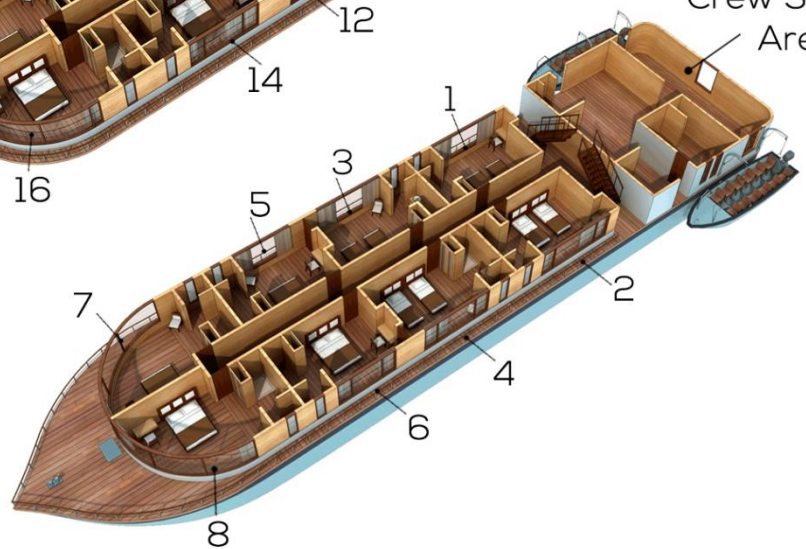

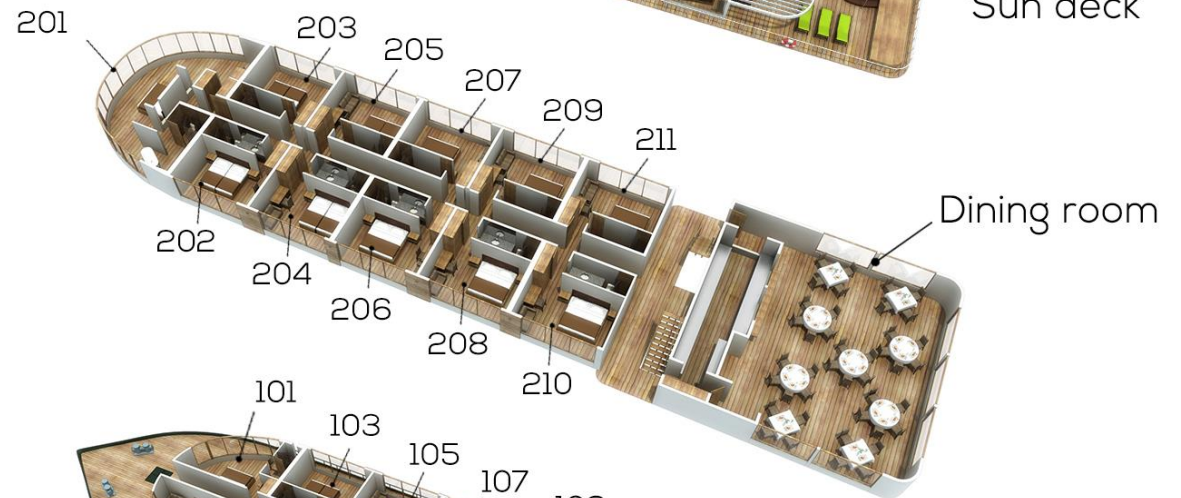
Delfin III - Deck Plan

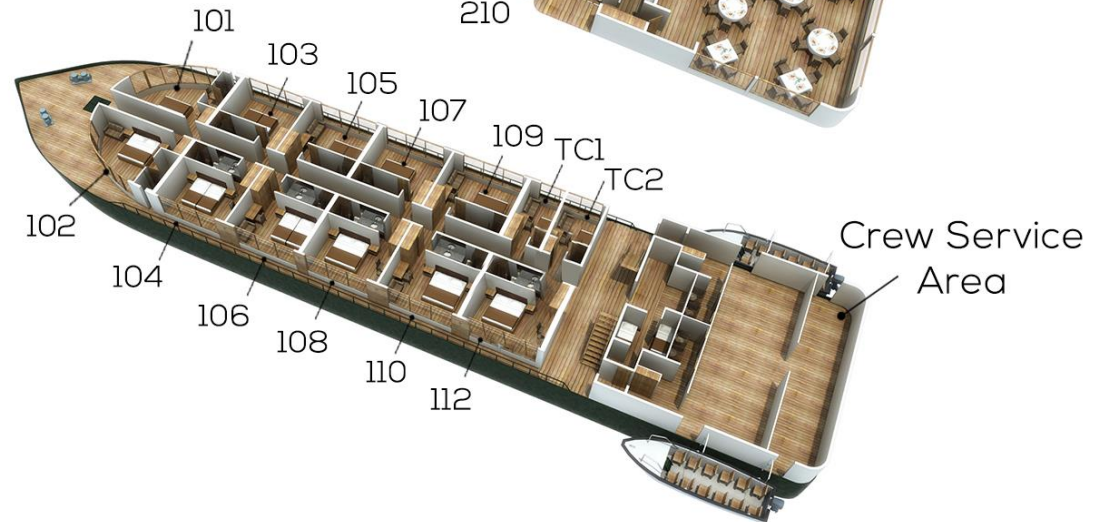
